

## PERSONAL DIVE EQUIPMENT LIST

### Dive Equipment:

Students are required to supply all personal diving equipment except for scuba cylinders. DIVESAFE INTERNATIONAL will supply air, scuba cylinders, full-face masks, underwater communications and other related equipment. Call DIVESAFE INTERNATIONAL for equipment purchase or rental options.

Student required equipment as follows:

- Wet suit or dry suit (dry suit is required for 5 dives) with hood, gloves, and boots
- Diving mask, snorkel and fins
- Buoyancy Compensator Device (BCD) (Weight Integrated is satisfactory)
- Weight Belt (or Integrated weights)
- Air delivery system consisting of a first stage, primary second stage, submersible pressure gauge and an alternate air source second stage (octopus, safe second, Air II or pony bottle with first and second stage regulators)
- Depth gauge and timing device (watch or bottom timer) a dive computer that does these functions is acceptable
- An underwater compass
- A dive knife
- An underwater light of sufficient size for night diving
- An underwater writing slate (5" x 7") with pencil
- Signal device such as a whistle and/or inflatable dive marker (both recommended)
- A proper gear bag or equipment container

### Other equipment (available from various sources)

- A Medic Alert bracelet or necklace indicating "Exposure to Compressed Air" or "Occupational Diver" A blank one can be engraved at a trophy engraver.
- Rigging knife or pocket-knife
- Pen, pencil, paper, binder, and basic calculator
- Rain gear, toque or hat, boots, change of clothes, dry towel and similar items for outside working environments
- Lunch, thermos or refreshments for diving days

**Note 1:** All diving equipment must be checked out and approved by the diving instructor prior to diving. **The instructor reserves the right to order service or condemn unsafe dive gear.**

**Students must supply a drysuit for portions of the course.**
